

Where will the jobs be in 2023?



1) Employment in Australia in the future

- Positive job growth in Australia is expected.
- There will be almost 900,000 more jobs in Australia by 2023.

2) Occupations that will have new jobs by 2023

- Aged and disability care workers (77,400)
- Registered nurses (65,300)
- Child care workers (25,800)
- Sales assistants (24,900)
- Waiters (21,800)
- Education support workers (21,900)
- Truck drivers (16,200)
- Software and applications programmers (15,100)

3) Why jobs will increase in these Industries

- Accommodation & food services – also referred to as the hospitality industry. Domestic and international tourism is increasing, more Australians are dining out and our Café society is growing.
- Healthcare, child care and disability care workers – an ageing population, more demand for childcare and the introduction of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).
- Construction – increased population requiring more homes and government funding for infrastructure such as freeways and railways.
- Education and training – increasing population of school children and more adults returning to study.
- Professional, scientific and technical services – high demand based on need for services, research growth and demand for technology.

4) Young people and jobs in the future

- Many young people are employed in industries where there will be an increase in jobs such as retail, accommodation, hospitality, and construction.

5) Technology and the future

- There will be an increasing use of different technology such as computers, 3D printers and smart phones in the workplace.
- There will be an increasing demand for skilled workers to develop and maintain technology such as app developers, 3D printer developers, drone pilots, data entry operators, social media and marketing professionals.
